INTRODUCTION


Ana was a thirteen year old girl, for her birthday they gave her flowers and a diary, in which she began to write every day

When Anna is born they move to Holland


Anna is family picture

Some time later a dentist joined the annex, he slept in the room with Anna, but they did not get along

running out of food



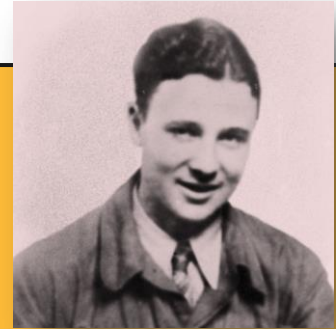
-After a few weeks he begins to use the newspaper to unload from so much confinement and write everything he felt; They heard on the news how many people died, that no one had food, they threw bombs, they robbed houses, only bad news

Ana did not have a good relation with her mother, they always fought, but with her father if they got along, he understood her more
I spent many years there and she counted all the changes of her as a woman



PETER AND ANNA

He fell in love with Peter Van Daan, she helped him study English, they spent every night together looking at the stars out the window, he told Ana that when she was happy he forgot all about problems ♥





On August 4, they were found by the police, they took everyone who was in the house in prison and took them to different concentration camps, Margot and Anna were always together. After spending time in the Westerbork and Auschwitz camps, Ana and Margot, her older sister, were taken to Bergen-Belsen. Both died during a typhus epidemic due to poor hygiene conditions.

Edith Frank died in Auschwitz on 6 January , 1945

Margot Frank died on 12 February , 1945

Anne Frank died in March 1945

Two months later they liberate all the people, only Otto Frank survives the holocaust, when he returns home he finds anna is diary, when he read to him he realized that anna is dream was for that diary to be published and he fulfilled it.

Years later it was one of the most widely read books in the world
